Teams subscriptions shall be done on time through the FISU Online Accreditation System via the "General Entry - Team Sport", or on paper via the "Final Engagement Form".

In order to be entitled to enter the team selection process and in addition to the aforementioned, delegations shall also pay to FISU a **team sport deposit** of:

- EUR 5,000 per registered Basketball, Football, Volleyball, Water Polo and Rugby Sevens team, or
- EUR 2,500 per Artistic Gymnastics team competition, Sailing and Table Tennis team tournament.

3) TEAM SELECTION CRITERIA

For the selection of teams, where the number of entries is larger than the authorised participating teams, the criteria defined in the concerned sports regulation will be applied.

The result of the team selection will be announced by email on 4 February 2019.

Selected teams have to confirm their arrival and departure via the FISU Online Accreditation System no later than one (1) month before the start of the tournament. Any delegation failing to fulfil this obligation may be considered as withdrawn, and a team from the reserve list could be invited for substitution.

5) DEPOSIT PAYMENT MODALITIES (General Regulations Art. 5.3.5)

The deposit of EUR 5,000 or EUR 2,500 (net value - bank charges paid by the member association) must be paid to the FISU bank account as stated underneath.

As soon as the "General Entry – Team Sport" form is submitted, the OAS will generate and send to member association an invoice for the above-mentioned team deposit, which will enable the member association to make the payment.

The OAS will generate one proforma invoice per all the teams registered at a time: e.g. Italy register three teams: Football Men, Rugby Sevens Women and Volleyball Women. One proforma invoice of EUR 15.000 will be created.

For the "Final Engagement Forms – Team Events", the same process will be manually applied.

The member association is kindly requested to indicate on the transfer a payment reference comprising the following information:

- the name of the association
- the name of the country / region
- the sport(s) concerned
- the gender concerned (if applicable)
- the proforma invoice number

For FISU's records, the member association is kindly asked to send a copy of the transfer to summer.universiade@fisu.net .

FISU will send a receipt to the member association.

6) CREDIT NOTE FOR SELECTED TEAMS

Should the team be selected and compete, FISU will credit the team sport deposit(s) to the remainder of the participation fees that the member association must pay to the Organising Committee.

The Head of Delegation must present the "FISU receipt" to the Organising Committee, upon arrival at the Summer Universiade Accreditation Centre.

7) CREDIT NOTE FOR NON-SELECTED TEAMS

Should a team not be selected, FISU will reimburse the team deposit upon receiving all bank details of the concerned beneficiary (e.g. NUSF, NSF, etc.).

8) WITHDRAWAL OF TEAMS

- a) Declaration of non-participation after having entered an official entry and before the team draw shall receive no penalty.
- b) Declaration of non-participation after the team draw has been held and more than sixty (60) days from the starting date of the competitions shall be sanctioned with the loss of the team deposit (50% for the Organising Committee and 50% to FISU).
- c) Declaration of non-participation after sixty (60) but more than twenty-one (21) days prior to the start of the official competition shall be sanctioned with:
 - a loss of the team deposit (50% for the Organising Committee and 50% to FISU);
 - to be placed lowest in that continent for consideration at the subsequent Summer Universiade team selection in the sport that has been withdrawn.
- d) Declaration of non-participation during the twenty-one (21) days immediately prior to the start of the competition shall be sanctioned with:
 - a loss of the team deposit (50% for the Organising Committee and 50% to FISU);
 - the exclusion from participation in that sport at the subsequent Summer Universiade.
- e) Withdrawal or non-appearance during the course of the competition shall be sanctioned with:
 - a loss of the team deposit (50% for the Organising Committee and 50% to FISU);
 - a compulsory reimbursement to the Organising Committee and FISU of the expenses borne on behalf of the withdrawing delegation and team, plus damages for loss of income and financial consequences;
 - exclusion from participation in that sport at the subsequent two (2) Summer Universiades and suspension from that sport if organised as a FISU World University Championship for three (3) years.
- f) Repetition of e) will require further disciplinary action by the EC, as advised by the FISU Disciplinary Committee.
